

Your Driver License (DL) or Identification Card (ID) will expire on your birthday – Renewal requirements have changed

To renew you **MUST** visit a DMV field office, have your picture taken, and do the following:

1. Bring **proof of your SSN**. Examples: your original Social Security card, copy of your income tax return filed with IRS or state, or military documents.*
2. Bring **proof that you are a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or are legally present in the United States**. Examples: A U.S. government issued birth certificate (must be an **original or certified copy**), a U.S. passport or passport card expired no more than 5 years, or an acceptable immigration document issued by the department of Homeland Security not expired.*
3. Bring **proof of your current full legal name** if your name is different than the name on your proof of citizenship or legal presence document.* Examples: An **original or certified copy** of your court issued marriage certificate/license, divorce or dissolution of marriage decree, adoption decree, or legal name change decree.
4. Bring **proof of your identity and date of birth**.* (This document could be the same as your proof of U.S. citizenship or proof of legal presence in the United States.)
5. Bring **proof of your current residence address** if your address has changed since your last DL/ID card was issued.* Examples: This notice may be used as proof of your current residence address **unless** it contains a mailing address (i.e. PO Box). Other acceptable proof is a utility bill, hookup order, monthly statement, mortgage document, or mail from a government agency dated within 60 days of application.
6. Pay the fee shown on the other side of this notice (checks payable to DMV or cash only).
7. **Driver License Renewals** –
 - Answer questions about medical conditions that may affect your driving ability.
 - Pass the vision screening test if you are over 50 years of age.
8. **CDL Renewals** – Present a valid medical certificate and, if you operate a CMV in interstate commerce, certify that you meet federal requirements.
9. **Disabled Parking Permit** – Complete a disabled parking permit renewal form (735-265B) when you renew your DL/ID.
